

Trumbull High sophomore wins Brain Bee competition

Vishakha Negi, a sophomore at Trumbull High School won the Regional Brain Bee organized by Trinity College in Hartford. Brain Bee is a neuroscience competition for high school students, aimed to motivate students to learn about the brain, to capture their imaginations, and to inspire them to pursue careers in biomedical brain research.

Vishakha will next represent Connecticut region at the USA National Brain Bee

Championship in March at the University of Maryland, Baltimore.

Last October Vishakha had represented Connecticut at the National FFA Creed Speaking Career Development Event (CDE), competing against Agriscience students from throughout the country, Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands, earning a bronze medal for her efforts.
