Teacher honored for law-related education

Brian Hendrickson, a social studies teacher at Hillcrest Middle School, was awarded the Mark R. Shedd Award by the Connecticut Consortium for Law and Citizenship Education, Inc. at the group's annual meeting and recognition dinner on June 10.

This award is given annually to a teacher who, in the opinion of the director, has made an outstanding contribution to law-related education in Connecticut during the pre-

ceding five or more years. The purpose of this award is to recognize imaginative and innovative ways, materials and learning experiences developed by a teacher that have been uniquely effective, and which will be a model for other teachers as they work with students.

Hendrickson holds a BS in Business Administration from Fordham U., a JD from Albany Law School and a Secondary Social Studies Certification from Southern Connecticut

State U. He has currently enrolled in the administrative preparation program at UConn.
