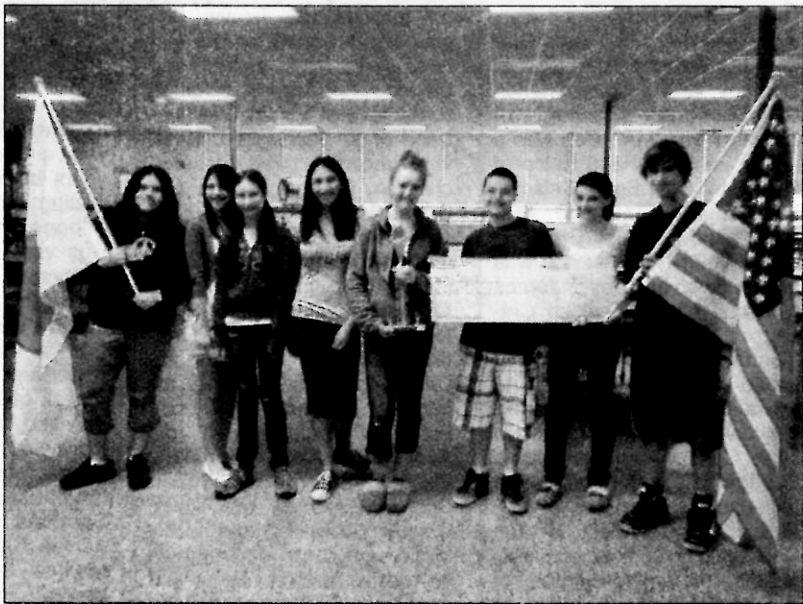


MIDDLE-SCHOOLERS LOVE TO HELP OUT
